## TEP-TEPE, AUTO Admission 2017

### Qualification

Applicants must have completed Grade 12 (Mattayom 6) in Sciences-Maths Programme or now study in Grade 12 in Math-Science Programme and are expected to achieve all the requirements for a high school certificate prior to entering the Programmes. For applicants graduating from an international school or abroad, the Certificate of Equivalence or its receipt issued by the Ministry of Education (Thailand) must be submitted to the TEP-TEPE, AUTO Programmes office before the Thammasat University registration date (at the beginning of August 2017).

\*\*\*For a possible entrance, candidates who are studying in Mathayom 6 in the major of sciences-maths programme or equivalent.

Application for admission to TEP – TEPE, AUTO Programmes can be processed through one of four sections below.

### TEPE Scholarship

Faculty of Engineering, Thammasat University offers full and partial scholarships to new TEPE, AUTO students with academic excellence.

**Full scholarships** : Recipients will be exempted from tuition fee and other educational support fees in each semester.

**Partial Scholarships** : Recipients will be exempted from tuition fee only, course fee 2,500.00 Baht/credit.

TEPE Programmes offer a *qualifying examination* in English in three subjects:

1. Mathematics
2. Sciences (Physics and Chemistry)
3. English

Procedure of qualifying : Written examination and Interview

### Written Examination

TEP-TEPE, AUTO Programmes offer a *qualifying examination* in English in three subjects:

1. Mathematics
2. Sciences (Physics and Chemistry)
3. English

Procedure of qualifying : Written examination and Interview

Notes: For any problems occurring during the admission process, the decision of the TEP-TEPE, AUTO committee is considered as the final one.

## Interview

Choose one of two options below:

### 1. Good academic records

GPA results of the candidates must contain at least 5 semesters (from the school that provide 2 semesters per year).

OR GPA results of the candidates must contain at least 7 semesters (from the school that provide 3 semesters per year).

Good academic records (GPA 3.00 or 75%)
GPA results of the candidates must contain at least 5 semesters (from the school that provide 2 semesters per year). The average GPA must be at least 3.00 (the full range GPA is 4.00) or 75%
GPA results of the candidates must contain at least 7 semesters (from the school that provide 3 semesters per year). The average GPA must be at least 3.00 (the full range GPA is 4.00) or 75%

English (*must not be more than 2 years ago)	
O-NET	at least 45%
IELTS*	at least 5.0 overall with not less than 4.0 in any element
TOEFL*	at least 61 on Internet-based test
CU-TEP	at least 60 equivalence TOEFL (Paper - based) score of at least 500
TU-GET*	at least 450
SAT (Critical Reading or Evidence-Based Reading and Writing)	at least 400
ACT (English & Reading)	at least 16

Note : 1. The GPA from student exchange programme can not be used for this application.

2. If candidates do not satisfy either of the above two conditions, they must take the written examination.

## 2. Standardized Test Score

Applicants must complete the Standardized Test Score with 3 subjects; Mathematics, Sciences and English. Applicants can submit one of the following test scores, if the minimum score listed below is met.

## Application steps and application documents

### Application steps

- ☞ Apply online via [www.tep.engr.tu.ac.th](http://www.tep.engr.tu.ac.th)
- ☞ Complete the form. Recheck the information before clicking “Submit” because after the submission, the information cannot be corrected.
- ☞ Print the payment form and pay (800.- Baht) for the application fee at KTB counter service.
- ☞ The application process will be completed after paying for the application fee and handing in all the application documents on time.
- ☞ If the applicant needs to change any information from the online process, he/she must reapply and repay the application fee. The previous payment and form of that applicant will be cancelled automatically. However, the reapplication process must be done on time (for each application period). The Programmes will consider the latest submission that has paid the application fee.

### Application Documents

- one recent one-inch photograph
- A photocopy of transcript of academic record from high school attended /or a photocopy of certificate or diploma earned
- A certificate of equivalence or its receipt issued by the Ministry of Education Thailand. (Required for applicants graduating from an international school or aboard.)
- A photocopy of the score report of Standardized Test Scores (Required for applicants applying by Interview)
- A photocopy of the score report of English Test Scores (Required for applicants applying by Interview)
- A photocopy of house registration (for Thai citizen)
- A photocopy of Citizen ID card (or passport for foreign nationals)
- A photocopy of receipt for application fee

**Note:** photocopies must be signed and certified by the applicant.
